Counseling through the Marion County Public Health Department (MCPHD) focuses on individual and family assessments and counseling. Counseling topics include, but are not limited to: depression, anxiety, behavioral issues, grief and loss, stress, anger management, peer relationships, conflict resolution, trauma, healthy coping skills, decision-making skills, and self-esteem building. MCPHD provides information and referrals to other community agencies and resources, if necessary. Anna Burse is the MCPHD counselor providing counseling services for Shortridge High School. Her main office is based out of the MCHPD Action Health Center, which provides mental and medical health care services for youth aged 27 and younger.
